

PHOTOGRAPHY SHOT LIST GUIDE

Knowing how many photos to take for your listing can be confusing and challenging. Use this guide to determine how many shots to take for each room.

INTERIORS

- Bedrooms - your standard bedroom only needs 1, max 2, photos.
- Master Bedroom: depending on the size you will need 2-3 photos to capture the layout and size. Be sure to capture a walk-in closet or on-suite bathroom
- Dining Room - 2 shots are perfect for your standard dining room
- Living Room - 2 wide angle shots
- Bathrooms - 1 wide angle shot unless it's the master bathroom which need 2-3

KITCHEN

- 2-3 shots (depending on the size) is perfect for the average kitchen.
- Capture the cabinet space & counter space. Highlight high end counters
- Shoot 1 extra shot for a kitchen that has a high end appliance, faucet or backsplash.

EXTERIORS

- Front Yards will need 2-3 photos to capture the curb appeal of the home.
- The Back Yard will need 3-5 photos to capture the space and any features such as a deck, pool, gazebo, views, etc.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Laundry Room - 1 shot
- Garages - 1 shot
- Finished Basements - 2/3 shots
- Unfinished Basements - 0/1
- Closets/Pantry - 0/1 depending on the size
